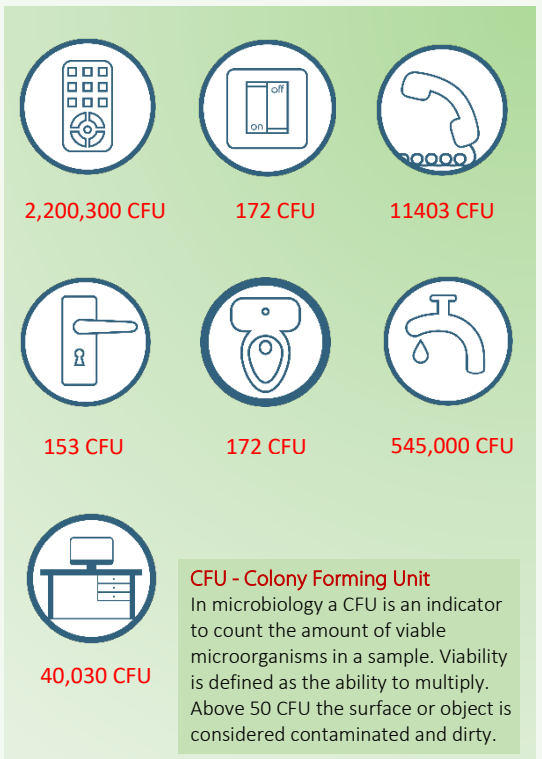


The **10** most important **contact points** in a **Hotel Room**



- 1 **Handles and Knobs** - Door handles, closets, drawers, furniture knobs and curtain rods
- 2 **Switches and Electronic Controls**
Lights, lamps, switches and electronic controls
- 3 **Bath Amenities** - Tissue boxes, soap dishes, small display trays and hair dryers.
- 4 **Climate Control Panel**
- 5 **Telephones, Remote Controls and Clocks**
- 6 **Bed, Bedding** - All bedding including comforter covers, pillowcases, sheets and headboard.
- 7 **Major Bathroom Surfaces** - Toilet handles and seats, splash walls, shower/tub controls and sink faucets
- 8 **Hard Surfaces and Furniture** - Table, desk, desk chair, couch, pillows on couch, nightstands and headboard
- 9 **Accessories in Closet**
Iron, safe and digital screen
- 10 **In-Room Beverages**
Mini-bars, kettle and coffee maker
